

## **Rules**

1. The students should strictly obey the instruction given by the principal from time to time.
2. The students should be regular in attendance for lectures & practicals.
3. The students should carry identity card always with them regularly and it should be produced if demanded by the authority.
4. The vehicle should be parked at a notified place. The vehicle parked elsewhere, i.e., other than parking zone shall be confiscated.
5. The student should not cause any damage to college property. The damage caused shall be compensated by the student immediately.
6. The attendance for the test and tutorials conducted in the college is compulsory.
7. The student having poor attendance and showing consistently poor performance in the test and tutorials shall not be permitted to appear for the University Examination.
8. The student should read the notices displayed on the notice board regularly and act accordingly. The college will not be responsible for the loss of any advantage due to negligence of reading notices on the part of the student.
9. The students found guilty by an act of misconduct either in college or outside shall be subjected to strict disciplinary action and may be expelled from the college.
10. The above rules of disciplines are always subject to change, modification, addition, omission or alteration and shall be modified, whenever the Principal deems it fit and proper. The decision of the Principal shall be final and binding to the students.

11. It is imperative that the students strictly adhere to the day of opening and closing of each term during the academic year. Registration during the given period is compulsory; else student will not be admitted in the subsequent term.
12. Smoking, chewing of tobacco and other such elements are strictly prohibited in the college as well as the campus.
13. Regularity is of utmost importance and thus absence at even a single lecture will be considered as absence for the day.
14. The college office should be informed in writing of any change in address of the student with immediate effect.
15. Insubordination and rude language or conduct is sufficient reason for the dismissal of the student. The student must remember that respect is the reciprocal of respect.
16. The student should not participate in any antisocial activities; otherwise the student will be liable to be expelled from the college.
17. The student should help in maintaining the building and campus clean and tidy.
18. Ragging is strictly prohibited as per the decision of the Hon. Supreme Court of India in writ petition No.(c)656/1998 and strict action will be taken against the students indulging in ragging.
19. Student should be present in neat and clean college dress.
